CMP Procedure Updates & Reminders

When you drop your child off each day you are required by state law to sign-in and note your sign-in time. Before you leave, please make sure that you check-in with the teacher so she is aware that your child has arrived.

When you pick up your child, you are required by state law to sign-out and note the sign-out time. Please be sure to check-in with the teacher so that she is aware that your child is departing.

When coming and going from the CMP parking lot, we encourage you to hold your child's hand and proceed cautiously. **Do not leave children unattended in the car at any time.**

We ask that you give your child the gift of your full attention when you pick them up from school.

General Tuition Information

Weekly tuition is due on Monday in advance for the week, and will be considered late if not paid by Friday. Monthly tuition is due on the 1st of the month in advance, and will be considered late after the 5th. A late charge of \$20.00 per week will be applied to your account until the balance is paid in full.

Communication with Parents

Communication between parents, teachers, administration, and students is essential for effective educational development. In your child's class you will find a memo on the parent board called, Memo to Parents, which outlines the day's activities.

Additionally there is a weekly lesson plan posted that outlines the early literacy unit, associated stories, songs, poems, and letters of the week.

Birthday Celebrations at CMP

Each child at CMP will be celebrated on their birthday with a birthday book from CMP and a birthday crown from their teacher. If you wish to enhance the celebration for your child we ask that you make arrangements with your child's teacher and bring in a non-edible treat.
