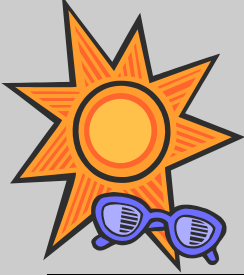

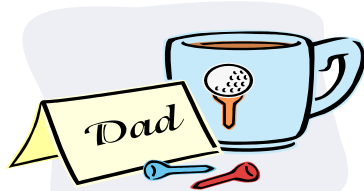
June Tuition
