# We love hearing all the great things you have to say about CMP!

"Thank you Carmel Mountain Preschool for instilling hope and love into our daughter's life. We came from another preschool that was slowly experiencing a high turnover and nearly twenty students to a classroom. After switching classrooms and enduring a bought of bullying, we happened by chance to encounter one of our older daughter's teacher that began working at Carmel Mountain Preschool, Ms. Nancy. She spoke highly of the school and I could tell from her enthusiasm that this was a place that she loved to be a part of. Soon after, we explored this top notch facility where there is an art studio, chicken coop, science nook with live animals, and tinker studio where children do woodworking. Also noteworthy to mention that there are three levels of playgrounds and a small class ration of 12:1. More importantly, I felt that there was a happy ambience and team work mentality. We felt welcome there right away.

After a few months at the school, I asked if there were any openings for full time because my husband was deploying with the Navy and we needed a full time position for our daughter. They worked hard to make accommodations for us, but at the same time, being mindful not to disrupt any current students with their teachers nor classrooms. They always worked in the best interest of the children.

This was further elucidated when we discovered a few months ago that our daughter was diagnosed with a genetic mutation, rendering her with mild to moderate hearing loss. Her inability to tolerate a large classroom setting made her unable to cope in the previous school with the large classroom size. When I beseeched Donna to move her a step down from the large classroom size of Kinder-Prep to Pre-K, even though the reservation had been made months early this year, she made the necessary changes to make sure Josephine stayed in a 12 student classroom so that her speech, occupational, and hearing therapies could be established in a quieter room and smaller group size. The school was amazing and accommodating for all the extra equipment, tutoring, and observations by our deaf and hearing specialist. She will get her hearing aids in a few weeks and the teachers are all aware of her condition. Ms. Nancy, especially, was open to learning and implementing whatever needed to be done to help Josephine understand and hear. She even wore a microphone during group activity times. Some of Josephine's social and developmental delay was due to her hearing loss and we had no idea at the time.

Josephine has only been shown love, care, and close attention by everyone at Carmel Mountain Preschool. In the one plus year that we have been there we have seen remarkable changes in her personality and enthusiasm for school. She has come out of her shell in the close friendships she has made there as well as with the wonderful teachers she has had. It warms my heart to know that such a place exists to provide support and care during this challenging year for us. We want to thank you from the bottom of our hearts. As a health care professional that specializes in children, I can assure you that I recommend this school wholeheartedly and that they treat your

child like family. Thank you Carmel Mountain Preschool for providing a wonderful foundation and for turning my child around to finally look forward to and enjoy school."




