Be an Earth hero!
















CONSCIOUS DISCIPLINE

My toddler is biting, what should I do?

Prevention

- Secure biters during transition times.
- Provide toys or snacks to engage the mouth.
- Keep distance between children during play.
- Provide a teething necklace.

Conscious Discipline 2/5

Stress Reduction

Locate and reduce stressors if possible. Then start a stress reduction program at home and school that includes:

- More touching (skin to skin for parents)
- "I Love You Rituals" with attuned interactions
- · Chest and lap time with downloading calm
- More visual schedules and routines
- Infant massage

Conscious Discipline

Shadow & Teach

There is nothing you can do to help a child learn other ways of getting his or her needs met after the bite has occurred. You must catch the child before the bite.

Most bites occur during transitions and non-structured time. Have a person shadow the child who is biting.

Conscious Discipline

When the child begins to bite:

- 1. Toss a **teething cloth** into the child's open mouth. The mouth will close.
- 2. Say, "You wanted ____ (take an educated guess as to what the child wanted). Say ____ (acceptable words) or do ____ (acceptable action)!"
- 3. Firmly say, "STOP. No bite! Ouch (make pained face) biting hurts."
- 4. Make **visuals** of alternatives to biting: My turn, play, move, etc.
