

Conscious Discipline Baby Doll Circle Time

What is Baby Poll Circle Time?

Children require one-on-one connections to thrive. Baby Doll Circle Time is an infant/toddler curriculum (that Pre-K and elementary children can access as well) that helps provide these **necessary connections** for every child without increasing staff time or staff numbers.

How to do Baby Poll Circle Time:

Baby Doll Circle Time consists of caregivers leading young children and their baby dolls in fun, engaging activities in a circle time setting. Caregivers also conduct these same interactions with each child individually. With this two-pronged system, the child re-experiences the connection with the caregiver whenever they play with their baby doll.



- Reduces the stress of out-of-home care by creating healthy attachments and improving the quality of caregiverchild relationships.
- 2. Increases the positive affect and joy between caregivers and children.
- Utilizes attachment, attunement, and social play to wire the brain for optimal development.
