SIFETY TIPS

Place strips of reflective tape on the back and front of costumes, so that drivers can better see your child.

Put your child's name, address, and phone number on their costume.

Costumes should fit properly to prevent trips and falls.

Do not use masks. Masks make it hard for children to see what's around them, including cars.

Turn on outdoor lights, and replace burnt-out bulbs.

Some children have food allergies. Consider giving treats other than candy, such as stickers, erasers or a small toy.

Put out a teal-colored pumpkin or a poster of one in your window to let children with food allergies know that what you're handing out is allergen-free (e.g., not food).

What is the Wish Well Ritual?

Wishing well involves creating a calm, loving internal state then "sending" that feeling to others. We can wish well children who are absent, upset or struggling, people we feel concerned about, and for local and global situations.

Wishing Well is a Three-Step Process:

1-Take a deep breath in.
2-Put your hands on your heart while filling your heart with love.
3-Send that love out to others while opening your arms and exhaling.

Older children can use specific mental images, and younger children can picture something they find precious.



Wishing Well Serves Three Purposes:

1-It centers us, setting our hearts and minds in alignment, which integrates our brain and activates our prefrontal lobes.

2-It prevents us from sliding back into the lower centers of the brain during conflict moments.

3-It radiates a coherent energy field of "all is well" that can upshift others from the lower centers to the higher centers of their brain.




