

SICK POLICY REMINDER

If your child gets sent home sick you will receive a sick report stating your child's symptoms and when they are able to return.

Carmel Mountain Preschool's sick policy states your child must be symptom free without the assistance of Tylenol, Ibuprofen, etc. for 24 hours

Currently, San Diego County requires a negative Covid test before returning to school. All tests must be emailed to Donna: donna@carmelmountainpreschool.com

If you do not wish to test your child, your child will need to be <u>72</u>
hours symptom free without the assistance of Tylenol, Ibuprofen, etc.

We will update you if the county's requirements change.

SICK POLICY REMINDER

Per the parent agreement:

- 4. "I understand that it is my responsibility to notify CMP office staff upon arrival if my child is on medication or has received immunizations or allergy tests within the last 24 hours."
- 23. "I understand in order to protect the safety and well being of children, staff, and parents at CMP, if my child has any of the following conditions, situations, or symptoms he or she is not allowed on the CMP Campus: temperature over 100.4 degrees, diarrhea, vomiting, jaundice, sore throat with fever, shortness of breath, dry cough, chills, repeated shaking with chills, muscle pain, headache, loss of smell or taste, infected cuts or wounds or lesions containing pus on an exposed body part"





CONSCIOUS DISCIPLINE

I LOVE YOU RITUALS

When a child is seeking attention they typically do not say "I need attention". Instead they may throw a temper tantrum, scream, throw a toy, hit, etc. At this time they are in an "Survival State" meaning they are seeking connection.

One way to meet this need is to do an "I love you ritual". This is a time with your child to create a safe, sacred space where there is eye contact, touch, presence, and in a playful environment. On the next page are a few I love you rituals you can use with your child.




